### WCAS members conduct "big sit" in CVNP

On Saturday, October 10, WCAS members conducted one of several bird walks in the Cuyahoga Valley National Park (CVNP) as part of a weekend-long celebration of the park's designation as an Important Bird Area (IBA). The WCASled walk began at Ira Road Trailhead and continued as a "big sit" of the beaver marsh observation deck for the rest of the morning.



# **Pumpkin Pie Squares by Alice Mitchell**

WCAS member Alice Mitchell treated the membership to pumpkin pie squares at the October 5 meeting. Everyone at the meeting gave them rave reviews. Alice was kind enough to share her recipe with us and here it is.

### Bottom crust:

- 3/4 cup flour
  1/2 cup quick oats
  1/3 cup brown sugar
  1/2 cup margarine softened
  1/2 cup chopped walnuts
  Filling: Mix all together
  1 1/2 cups pumpkin
  3 extra large eggs beaten
- 3/4 cup sugar
  1/2 teaspoon salt
  1/2 teaspoon ginger
  1/2 teaspoon cloves
  1 teaspoon cinnamon
  1/4 teaspoon nutmeg
  1 1/4 cup milk
  1 six oz. can or 3/4 cup Pet Milk

Press bottom crust ingredients together in a 9 x 13" pan and bake at 350° for 12 minutes or until light brown. Cool slightly.


Pour in filling. Bake at 350° for 35 minutes or ntil filling is set. Cool. Refrigerate.
