NEW ENGLAND ASTER ~ *Symphotrichum novae-angliae*

PURPLE CONEFLOWER ~ *Echinacea purpurea*

RED MAPLE ~ *Acer rubrum*

SCARLET BEEBALM ~ *Monarda didyma*

WILD GERANIUM ~ *Geranium maculatum*

SWAMP MILKWEED ~ *Asclepias incarnata*

SWITCH GRASS ~ *Panicum virgatum*

TRUMPET CREEPER ~ *Campsis radicans*

WINTERBERRY ~ *Ilex verticillata*

EUROPEAN PRIVET ~ *Ligustrum vulgare*

GLOSSY BUCKTHORN ~ *Frangula alnus*

JAPANESE BARBERRY ~ *Berberis thunbergii*

MYRTLE OR PERIWINKLE ~ *Vinca minor*

NON-NATIVE HONEYSUCKLES ~ *Lonicera* spp.

NORWAY MAPLE ~ *Acer platanoides*

ORIENTAL BITTERSWEET ~ *Celastrus orbiculatus*

PURPLE LOOSESTRIFE ~ *Lythrum salicaria*

REED CANARY GRASS ~ *Phalaris arundinacea*

WINTER CREEPER ~ *Euonymus fortunei*
