Find out what's happening at the Dike 14 Nature Preserve where soils dredged from the Cuyahoga River have become a unique and diverse natural habitat. The 88-acre wildlife haven on the shores of Lake Erie in the heart of Cleveland is now home to native Ohio plants, trees and animals. Hour-long hikes begin on the half hour. Boat tour tickets are limited and given first come, first served.

Parking is available at Gordon State Park. Entrances from N. Marginal at E. 72nd Street, from North Marginal between E. 72nd and MLK, and park office entrance from Lakeshore Boulevard east of MLK. Additional space at E. 55th State Park (Exit SR 2). Please arrive 15 minutes before your chosen walk to sign a waiver and receive additional information.
